On a mission to find a legendary treasure map, a teen pirate captain will brave most anything.

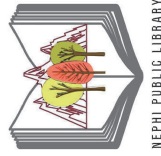
***House of Salt and Sorrows* by Erin A. Craig**

Youthful folly, social change, and the siren song of the next wave submerge the reader in the crosscurrents of autobiography, social history, and pure adventure.



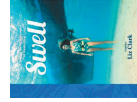
**Jack London's Racial Lives** by Jeanne Campbell Reesman
