An Appetite For Violets by Martine Bailey

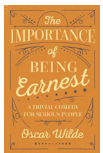
An undercook is swept up into a world of scheming, secrets, and lies when her elderly master marries a young woman.

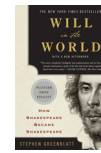
Azincourt by Bernard Cornwell

Middlemarch by George Eliot

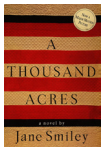
Intersecting storylines render the portrait of a Victorian community on the brink of change.

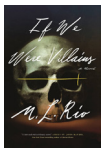
A Thousand Acres by Jane Smiley
